One School, One Book is a program designed to create a shared reading experience within a single elementary school community. Every student in the elementary school will read that book over the course of 4-5 weeks. Activities done at school and at home promote and enrich the shared reading experience. Activities, a reading calendar, links to online audio chapters, and chapter notes will be sent home with each student, so families can also participate in this experience. The culmination of the book will coincide with our **Annual Spring Family Literacy Night on May 17th**.
